

Activating and deactivating plugins in WordPress

WordPress offers a large number of plugins to add functionality to your site. They range from anti-spam comment filters to helping you build a small-scale social network. **To activate a plugin** Log in to WordPress. Click Â Plugins. Click Â Add New. Search for the plugin you want to use, and then click Â Install Now. Click Â Activate Plugin. How you manage and use the plugin depends on its developer. You can view all of the currently installed plugins by clicking Â Plugins Â on the menu. Some WordPress plugins can slow your site's performance. Deactivating plugins and then testing your site's performance again can help you troubleshoot speed issues. **To Deactivate WordPress Plugins** Log in to WordPress. Click Â Plugins. Select all of the plugins you want to deactivate, and then from the Â Bulk Actions Â menu, select Â Deactivate, and then click Â Apply.
