Select all of the text found in the **option_value** field, copy it, and paste it into a text editor. Once the text was copied to a safe place, you can delete it from phpMyAdmin. Click **Go** to submit the change. You can re-enable your plugins at any time by editing theÂ **active_plugins** entry again and pasting in the text you removed earlier.
