Change your WordPress password with WP-CLI

If you installed [WP-CLI](#) on your server to manage your WordPress site, then you can follow these steps to update your password. If you have not setup WP-CLI, then you will need to do so before using these steps. You should always backup your site before performing any changes. [Connect to your server or shared hosting account with SSH](#) Change to the root directory for your WordPress site. Use the following command to view a list of users for your WordPress site. Make note of the ID number for the user you want to update.

```
$ wp user list
```

Use the following command to update the password for that user.

```
$ wp user update id --user_pass=password
```

id is the number you located in Step 4 **password** is your new password You can now login with your new password
