You can sell PDF Product Vouchers to customers that can be redeemed for products and services in your WooCommerce store. There are two types of vouchers: single-purpose and multi-purpose. This article will help you understand the differences between each voucher type and decide which type of voucher you should create. Required: PDF Product Vouchers is a premium WooCommerce extension included with WordPress Ecommerce Hosting or as a standalone purchase. Single-purpose vouchers are vouchers that are associated with and redeemable for a specific product or service only. The voucher redemption offsets 100% of the product, even if the voucher itself is sold for less than the redemption product's cost. We recommend ensuring that your single-purpose voucher uses the same tax class as the products it can be used on, since redeeming a single-purpose voucher will offset 100% of the product price, even if it's more. Multi-purpose vouchers are vouchers that are redeemable for any product in your store. These vouchers offset the cart total and can be thought of as being used like a gift card. If only part of the voucher's value is used, it is considered partially redeemed and can be used again at a later date. Disclaimer: If you're not sure whether a voucher should be taxed at purchase or not, please consult your tax attorney or accountant. Our documentation can help guide your decisions around voucher taxation, but tax compliance is your responsibility as a merchant. Please be careful to choose the right options for your store. The key

differences between single-purpose and multi-purpose vouchers are outlined in the following table:

Redeemable for	A single product (good or service).	Any product (good or service).
Redemption amount	100% of the product price that the voucher is being redeemed for; the voucher is applied to the highest priced item eligible for redemption regardless of voucher value.	Same as the voucher amount / cost of the voucher.
Partial redemption?	No.	Yes.
When is voucher applied?	To the product price, before taxes are calculated on the product.	To the cart total. The order total (after taxes) is offset by the voucher value.
