

## If I've changed the nameservers for my domain, why does it still appear on my list of domains?

The nameservers do not determine where a domain is registered, only that the DNS is managed on those servers.Â nameservers repeatedly over the course of a domain's lifespan, but still keep it with the same registrar. Therefore, you can have a domain name here at Heart Internet, even if you are hosting the website elsewhere. If you want to change where a domain is registered, you must complete a domain name transfer. Your new registrar should have information on how to transfer a domain.
