

How do I transfer my gTLD domain name out of my account?

The gTLD domain names (such as .com, .net, and .org) require interaction between the domain administrator and both registrars. To fully transfer your domain name away: Log into your Heart Internet Customer Area Click 'Manage Domain Names' Select the domain name you want to transfer, and click 'Manage Now' Click 'Domain Locking' Ensure your domain name is unlocked If your domain is locked, click the link to unlock the domain Click "Domain Auth Code" to get your transfer code Go to your new registrar and set up a transfer request Enter in the transfer code when asked Your administrative email will receive an email regarding the domain transfer Respond to that email as soon as possible The transfer will be processed Please allow for up to seven days for the transfer to fully complete.
