

Enable root or admin access to my server

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Here's how to enable root (sudo or substitute/super user) access to your VPS. You might need this kind of access to install applications or make high-level changes to your server configuration. Log in to your account. ([Need help logging in?](#)) In your Customer Area, click Manage VPS and Hybrid Servers, and next to the server you want to use, click Manage. In the account Dashboard, at the top of the page select Settings. Select settings In the Access section, next to Admin Access, click Manage. Select Enable Admin Access (root account sudo access) then click Save. In the Settings section, Admin access is now enabled. Â
