

## Use the Recovery Console for my VPS

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Use the Recovery Console to regain access to your VPS if you've been inadvertently locked out by a new firewall or iptables rule. You need to know your server username and password to connect to your server via SSH or Remote Desktop (RDC). **Required:** If port 2224 is blocked, you can't access the Recovery Console.. Log in to your account. ([Need help logging in?](#)) In your Customer Area, click Manage VPS and Hybrid Servers, and next to the server you want to use, click Manage. In the top left corner of the account **Dashboard**, select **Recovery Console**. Press Enter. You can now log into your server to make changes.
