This is related to the configuration of PHP on our servers, but can be easily circumvented by adding some code to a configuration file. To fix this problem: Download your site.php file in your /config/ directory Add this line to your site.php file: define('SERVER_PATH_VARIABLE', 'REDIRECT_URL'); Download your .htaccess file Add these lines to your .htaccess file: RewriteEngine On

RewriteBase /

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} !-f

RewriteCond %{REQUEST_FILENAME} !-d
