If the CGI binary was written in a language such as C, it may not run if it was compiled on a different platform, such as a Sun Solaris machine. When you compile the binary, you will need to compile it on a 0x86 Linux platform. If the program was written in a scripting language such as ASP, PHP, or Perl, you need to make sure that it has the correct interpreter line at the start of the script.
