When a visitor goes to your site by typing in a directory, such as `www.your-domain.com/shop/`, your server has a list of default document extensions that it will serve as the index page for that directory.Â If you have several index files in there, there is a specified order that it will serve those files â€ first looking for one file extension, then the next, then the next, until it finds a valid index file with a valid extension. The priority list for Linux/Apache servers is: `index.cgi index.pl index.asp index.html index.html.var index.shtml index.php index.php3 index.htm default.htm default.asp` The priority list for Windows/IIS servers is: `index.cgi index.pl default.asp index.asp index.html index.html.var index.shtml index.php index.php3 default.htm index.htm iisstart.htm default.aspx index.aspx`
