

How do I set up a mailbox in Mozilla Thunderbird?

To have your email account load into your Mozilla Thunderbird, you can set it up through an IMAP connection. To set it up: Open Thunderbird on your computer Under "Accounts", click "View Settings for this account" The Account Settings Box will open with an account name of "Local Folders", depending on your configuration At the bottom left corner, click the "Account Actions" drop-down list Click "Add Mail Account" Enter in the Name of the account Enter in your email address Enter in your password Click "Continue" Click the "Manual Config" button In the new pop-up window, please add the following information: Incoming: IMAP Server Hostname: mail.(your domain name) Port: 143 SSL: None Authentication: Encrypted Password Outgoing SMTP: mail.(your domain name) Port: 587 SSL: None Authentication: Normal Password Username, Incoming: (Your email address) Username, Outgoing: (Your email address) When your settings are filled in, please click "Done" and your mailbox will be configured
