

Nameserver ownership checks for domain references

If you've added a domain reference to your Heart Internet account and want to use our nameservers, you'll need to show our system that you control the domain name by taking some extra steps. After the domain reference has been added, you won't be able to change the DNS for the domain name until our system can see that you have control of the domain registration. We check this by monitoring the nameservers that the domain is set to use. Before DNS is enabled on our system, you will need to set the domain name to use a third party set of nameservers and allow 24 hours for our system to notice this. After 24 hours have passed, you can set the domain name to use either of our available nameservers: ns.mainnameserver.com ns2.mainnameserver.com Or ns.heartinternet.uk ns2.heartinternet.uk
