It is assumed that you are using Plesk as a Service Provider. If you are using Plesk as Power User, switch to Service Provider: Go to the 'Server' tab Go to 'Interface Management' Go to 'Panel Appearan Click 'Service Provider' Click 'OK' You will now be in Service Provider mode Then create a new subscription for you website: Click 'Subscriptions' Click 'Add New Subscription' Give the subscription a name Enter a username and password for the subscription Add the features you need for the site Click 'OK' You will now have a hosting account your site If you want to log into Plesk as your new subscription, you can do that now. Otherwise, on the Subscripti page, click on Open in Control Panel to open the subscription's control panel. You now can decide on whether or no move your files over using the File Manager or using FTP. With Plesk, all files that went into /public\_html/ in your previous account will now be in /httpdocs/. To move your files over using the Plesk File Manager: Click the 'Website Domains' tab Click 'Plesk File Manager' Click into the httpdocs directory Upload the files through the File Manager T move your files over using FTP: Open your FTP client Use the IP address as the host Use the username and passw that you set when you created the subscription Click into the httpdocs directory Upload the files through FTP Now c and upload your database: Click the 'Websites & Domains' tab Click 'Databases' Create a new database, making su that the database name is the same as it was in eXtend Create a new user for the database, making sure the userna and password are the same as they were in eXtend Go to 'Webadmin' Load 'phpMyAdmin' Click the 'Import' tab Sele the SQL file from your computer Click 'Import' Your database will now be attached to your site. Test your site, then me your domain name. You can switch the DNS in your Heart Internet Control Panel or use the Express DNS Wizard Manage VPS area. It will take 24-48 hours for your transfer to propagate throughout the Internet.
