Domain-based Message Authentication, Reporting, and Conformance (DMARC) is a system which tells a receiver how to handle emails which may not pass Sender Policy Framework (SPF) or DomainKeys Identified Message (DKIM) checks. You can read more about it [here](#).

Does Heart Internet perform DMARC checks?

No, our mail servers do not check incoming emails for DMARC keys at present.

Can I add DMARC support for my domain?

DMARC only requires a Domain Name System (DNS) record to be added in the form a TXT record. This can be added if on our nameservers, but please note that we do not perform checks in incoming emails.
