

My .app domain gives a "Not Secure" error.

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.app domain names are pre-loaded with [HTTP Strict Transport Security](#) (HSTS), which means that the domain will always default to the **HTTPS://** protocol, rather than **HTTP://**. This means that any .app domain name must use an Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) certificate, otherwise a warning will display. You can purchase an SSL certificate from your [Customer Control Panel](#).
