

Edit FTP users in my Linux Hosting account

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Use the cPanel FTP manager to edit the password and quota for FTP users in your Linux Hosting account. Go to your Heart Internet [customer area](#) and select **cPanel Hosting**. Select the your desired cPanel hosting account and select **Login**. In the upper left corner of the account **Dashboard**, click **FTP Manager**. In the cPanel **FTP Accounts** page, in the **FTP Accounts** section, next to the FTP user account you want to edit, select either **Change Password** or **Change Quota**. Make your changes and then click **Change Password** or **Change Quota**. **More info** You *can't* edit the path to the working directory for an FTP user account in cPanel. You must delete the user account, create a new one, and assign a new working directory to the new account. For help with cPanel, see the [cPanel documentation for the FTP Accounts feature](#).
