

Enable SSH for my Linux Hosting account

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SSH is a secure method of connecting to your Linux Hosting account to move files and execute commands. Follow these steps to enable SSH for your account - you don't need to configure any public or private keys. Go to your Heart Internet [customer area](#) and select **cPanel Hosting**. Select the your desired cPanel hosting account and select **Login**. In the account **Dashboard**, under **Settings** click **Server**. Next to **SSH access**, click **Manage**. Click the **SSH access** switch to turn it on. The switch turns green and your SSH credentials appear in the list. Use these credentials to log in to cPanel via SSH.
