Open a new file in your text editor Paste in the following code: <?php

```
$dbhost = 'localhost';  
$dbuser = '[DATABASE USERNAME]';  
$dbpass = '[DATABASE PASSWORD]'; $conn = mysql_connect($dbhost, $dbuser, $dbpass) or die ('Error  
connecting to mysql'); $dbname = '[DATABASE NAME]';  
mysql_select_db($dbname);
```

?> Replace [DATABASE USERNAME] with the name of your database user.Â Replace [DATABASE PASSWORD] with the password for your database user.Â Replace [DATABASE NAME] with the name of your database. Save this file as [NAME].php and upload it to your account. When you want to access the database in any PHP script: Add the following line to your script: include '[NAME].php' The database can now be queried, using standard SQL commands, and the following line: mysql_query('QUERY')
