

Manually install an SSL certificate on my cPanel

Go to your account. Access the server you would like to install the certificate on. Clickâ€cPanel Admin. In theâ€Securityâ€section, clickâ€SSL/TLS. Underâ€Certificates (CRT), clickâ€Generate, view, upload, or delete SSL certificates. Use theâ€Upload Certificateâ€section to upload the primary certificate (.crtâ€file with randomized name) from your local machine and clickâ€Upload Certificate. On the new page, clickâ€Go Back. Scroll down to the bottom of theâ€SSL Certificatesâ€page and clickâ€Return to SSL Manager. Underâ€Install and Manage SSL for your site (HTTPS), clickâ€Manage SSL Sites. Scroll down to theâ€Install an SSL Websiteâ€and clickâ€Browse Certificates. Select the certificate that you want to activate and clickâ€Use Certificate. This will auto-fill the fields for the certificate. Scroll down to the bottom of the page and clickâ€Install Certificate. On the Successfully Installed pop up, clickâ€OK.
